- 18. Feasibility Study
 - i. As a result of a discussion Councillor Stevens had with ESCC Highways Councillors asked him to get prices to repaint the white lines on the Wartling Road and Boreham Street because it will make the roads look narrower and help reduce speeding. Highways told Councillor Stevens they will not accept any other measures at the current time.
 - ii. The Safer Wealden Partnership has agreed to lend Wartling Parish Council a Black Cat Speed Monitoring Device provided those who use it have received training. The members of Speedwatch have agreed to undertake the training required. The device will then be used to collect traffic data.

19. <u>Questions from Parish Councillors</u>

Councillor Shine said he attended a meeting with Sussex Police in March where he was told about Operation Downsway.

Operation Downsway is its annual campaign to tackle anti-social road users and positively influence drivers and motorcyclists to drive responsibly, considerately, and safely.

Every weekend between April and September officers from teams across the force will take part in the dedicated operation, providing a highly visible presence on the road network in Sussex and taking enforcement action where necessary.

Councillor Stevens asked the Parish Council to consider sponsoring a prize at this year's Windmill Hill Summer Show. This will be an item for the next Parish Council Meeting agenda.
